The meeting will be governed by the General Regulations of the Royal Automobile Club Motor Sports Association Ltd., (Incorporating the provisions of the International Sporting Code of the FIA), these and further Supplementary Regulations and any further written instructions that the Organising Club may issue for the event.

Races WILL NOT BE run in the order shown on this form.

ELIGIBLE COMPETITORS: The event is open to fully paid up members of the Classic Touring Car Racing Club, BARC and the Red Dragon Race and Track Club. All competitors must be holders of a current MSA Racing Licence & Medical Certificate. Licences, Medical Certificate and Club Membership Cards WILL be examined at signing-on. Please note that strict checks will be made on current club membership to maintain MSA insurance.

ENTRIES AND STARTERS: The organisers have the right to select or refuse entries. The maximum for the meeting is 480. The minimum is 150. The maximum for each qualifying session and race is as per the MSA Track Licence. Should any of the minimum figures not be reached the organisers have the right to either cancel the race or amalgamate races or classes as necessary.

ENTRY DEFINITIONS: Each basic entry will qualify for four personnel passes. Each entry will qualify the competitor for a listing in the official programme of the sponsor/team name. This listing will be a maximum of six words and must contain no offensive or misleading statements. All other restrictions on certain types of advertising must be respected. For all entries made supported by an International or National Entrants Licence, the listing in the official programme must match the title on the Entrant's Licence.

ACCEPTANCE / REFUSAL OF ENTRIES: Entries will be accepted up to the closing date specified on this form subject to the maximum numbers specified above. Faxed entries will only be accepted if they are sent in accordance with MSA D12.2. Faxed entries received before or after, will be held in abeyance unprocessed, pending receipt of the original form and entry fee. All entries received after the closing date specified will be accepted or refused at the discretion of the Club. No entries whatsoever will be accepted after 12.00 noon on the Wednesday prior to the meeting and to meet this deadline the original entry form and payment must have been received by the Secretary of the Meeting. Any change of entry must be in accordance with MSA D25.1.12.

REFUNDS: Entries withdrawn on or before the closing date will receive a refund of entry fees in full. Entries withdrawn between the Closing Date and the Final Closing Date will receive a refund less an administration fee of £25. Entries withdrawn after the Final Closing Date will receive a refund, less an administration fee, at the discretion of the Club. Reserves who practice, but fail to gain a place on the Starting Grid will receive a refund less a charge of £40. In the event of cancellation entrants will either have their entry fees transferred to an acceptable future event or refunded in full. MSA H31.1.2.

RESULTS AND PROTESTS: Provisional results will be published as soon as possible after each race. Protests should be made in accordance with MSA C5.

START POSITIONS: These will be determined by Qualifying Times.

Standing starts will be used for Thermex Classic and Historic Touring Car Championship, Autoglym Post Historic Touring Car Championship, Hammerite Classic Group One Touring Car Championship, Federal Tyres Nippon Challenge and Silverstone Tyres MR2 Racing Series races.

Rolling starts will be used for Platinum Press Classic Thunder Championship incorporating the BOSS Series, BOSS Series non-championship, CTCRC Allcomers Saloons & Sports Car Challenge, BARC SEC Tin Tops and BARC Intermarque races. Start penalties will be in accordance with MSA Regulations.

There will be separate timed Qualifying Sessions for all races, except the Thermex Classic & Historic Race two; BARC SEC Tin Tops Race Two, BARC SEC Intermarque Race Two, Federal Tyres Nippon Challenge Race Two, Silverstone Tyres MR2 Racing Series Race Two and CTCRC Allcomers Saloons and Sports race two which will be determined by the finishing order in the respective race one.

Drivers should complete at least three laps to qualify for a place on the grid.

Drivers practising out of session or who qualify only through familiarity of the circuit will be placed at the back of the grid.

The maximum number of starters for each race will be as specified in the Track Licence.

SCRUTINEERING ETC.: All vehicles must comply with MSA Vehicle, Formula and Tyre regulations. Competition numbers must conform to MSA Vehicle regulations.

REGULATIONS: All other Regulations of the MSA, Championship/Challenge Regulations and any other SRs issued by the organisers.

AWARDS: As per Championship/Challenge Regulations.

INSURANCE: All competitors are insured in respect of Third Party Liability during official practice and racing. For further details see current MSA Yearbook.
